Town of Lenroot Annual News Letter

In early July, Roger Hoff, long time Lenroot resident and Town Board member passed away. Roger's good judgment and quick smile will be missed. Mike Bandow was selected to complete the term.

2017 road projects completed were part of Company Lake Rd-blacktop/gravel, Janet Rd-gravel, Old OO-gravel, Northern Lights Rd, Small Rd, Thannum Fire La, Leo's Rd-crack sealing. Three patches were also done on Nelson Lake Road to hopefully correct major frost heaves.

2018 road development projects being considered are grinding and relaying the south part of Mosquito Brook Road and Ewig Lane Road, resurfacing Wagner Circle Road, graveling part of Thannum Fire Lane. 20,000 yards of gravel will need to be crushed to complete graveling of Thannum and Phipps Fire Lanes.

A new tandem axle truck, snow plow, wing and sander has been ordered and is scheduled to arrive in January 2018. A new tractor will be considered for purchase by next summer. Replacing the grader will be considered as finances allow in the next few years.

The 2018 budget was approved on November 13th with a levy of \$330,102. This means the township portion of your property tax bill will remain the same as last year.
